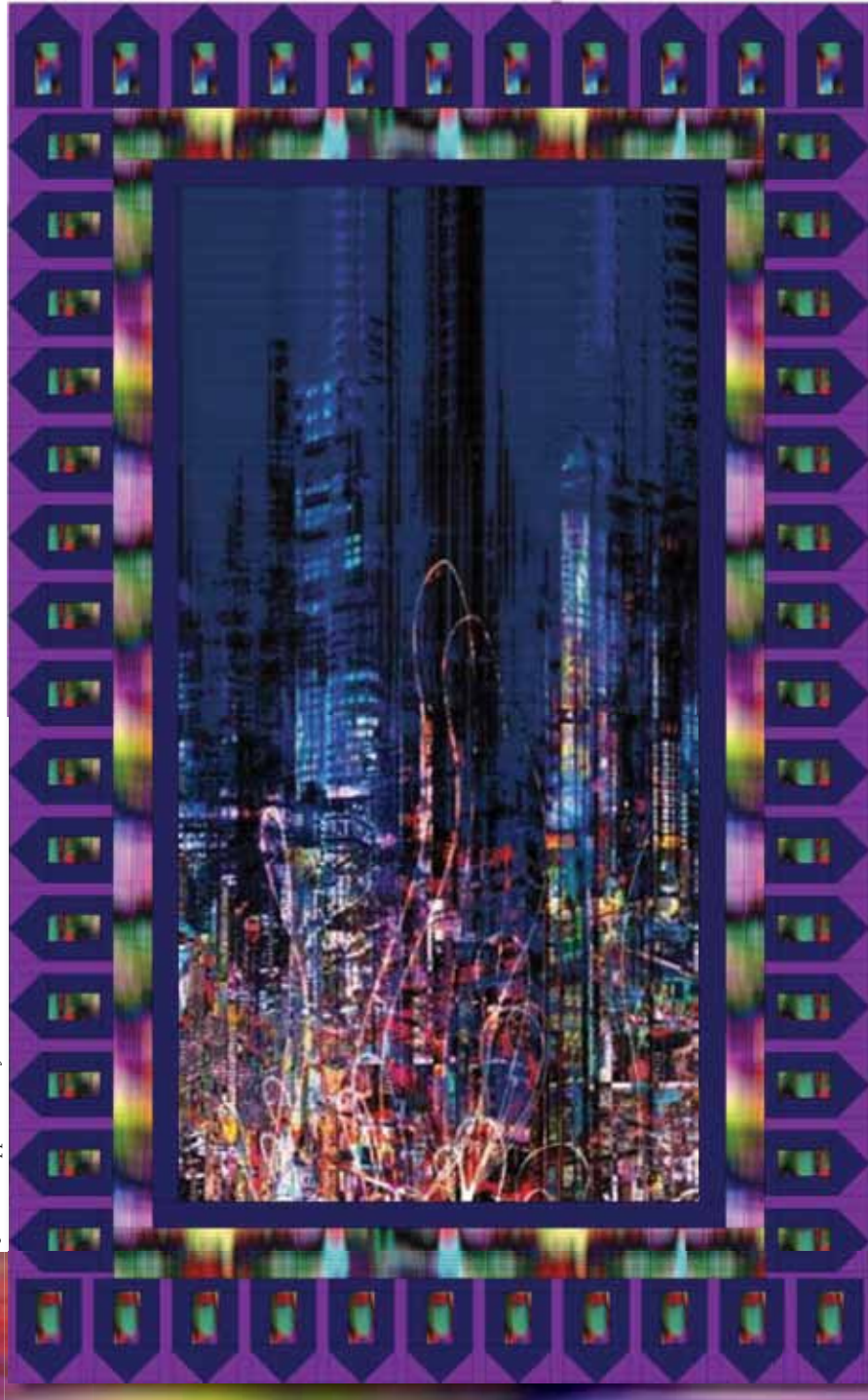

Quilt design by Cathey Laird of Cathey Marie Designs



Quilt size: approximately 33" x 53"

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS:

Yardages are based on 40" wide, unwashed fabric.

- A. Pattern #26625 – MUL 11 panel
- B. Pattern #26626 – MUL 1⁵/₈ yard
- C. Dark blue fabric of choice 1³/₈ yards
- D. Dark purple fabric of choice.....⁵/₈ yard
- Backing of choice.....2¹/₂ yards
- Batting..... 41" x 61"

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS:

Please read all instructions carefully before beginning. ¹/₄" seam allowance is included in measurements and all strips are cut across the width of the fabric unless noted otherwise. Label pieces and keep together until ready to sew. These instructions are based on unwashed fabrics.

PIECING INSTRUCTIONS:

A. House Blocks

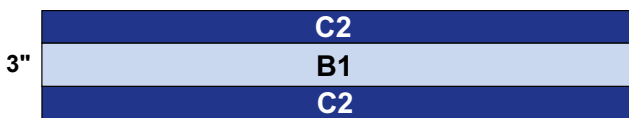


Figure 1 Make 4.

- Sew ¹/₄" C2 strips to opposite long sides of one ¹/₂" B1 strip. Press seams toward C2. Strip set should measure 3" wide. Make four strip sets (Figure 1).

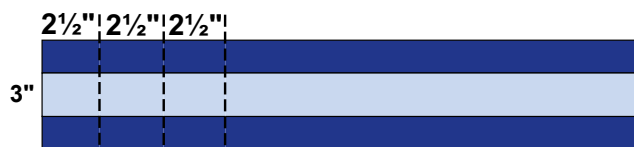


Figure 2 Cut 52.

- Cut strip sets into fifty-two ²/₁₂" x 3" CBC units (Figure 2).

- Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of all ¹/₄" D2 squares.
- Place one ¹/₄" D2 square right sides together on the top left corner of a 2" x 3" C3 rectangle. Sew on the line (Figure 3).
- Trim seam allowance to ¹/₄". Fold corner out and press seam toward triangle (Figure 3).
- Repeat on the top right corner (Figure 3). Make fifty-two roof units.

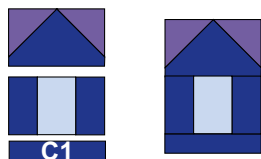


Figure 4 Make 52.

- Sew one roof unit to the top of one CBC strip unit. Press toward roof. Sew one C1 strip to the bottom. Press toward strip. Make fifty-two House blocks (Figure 4).

- Sew fifteen House blocks together with fourteen D1a strips and add a D1b strip to each end to make a ⁴/₁₂" x ⁴⁵/₁₂" House side strip. Press seams toward the House blocks. Make two (Quilt Diagram).
- Sew eleven House blocks together with ten D1a strips and add a D1b strip to each end to make the ⁴/₁₂" x ³³/₁₂" House top strip. Press seams toward the House blocks. Repeat to make the bottom House strip (Quilt Diagram).

A. Pattern #26625 – MUL 1 (panel):

- Trim panel to 20¹/₂" x 39¹/₂", centering image.

B. Pattern #26626 – MUL 1 (texture):

- Cut four ¹/₂" strips.
- Cut two 2" strips. Subcut two 2" x 4¹/₂" strips.
- Cut two ²/₁₂" strips. Subcut two ²/₁₂" x 25¹/₂" strips.

C. Pattern #26459 – DKBLU 1 (texture):

- Cut four 1" strips. Subcut fifty-two 1" x 3" rectangles.
- Cut eight ¹/₄" strips.
- Cut four 2" strips. Subcut fifty-two 2" x 3" rectangles.
- Cut two ¹/₂" strips. Subcut two ¹/₂" x 39¹/₂" strips.
- Cut two ¹/₂" strips. Subcut two ¹/₂" x 22¹/₂" strips.
- Cut five ²/₄" strips for binding.

D. Pattern #26459 – DKPUR 1 (texture):

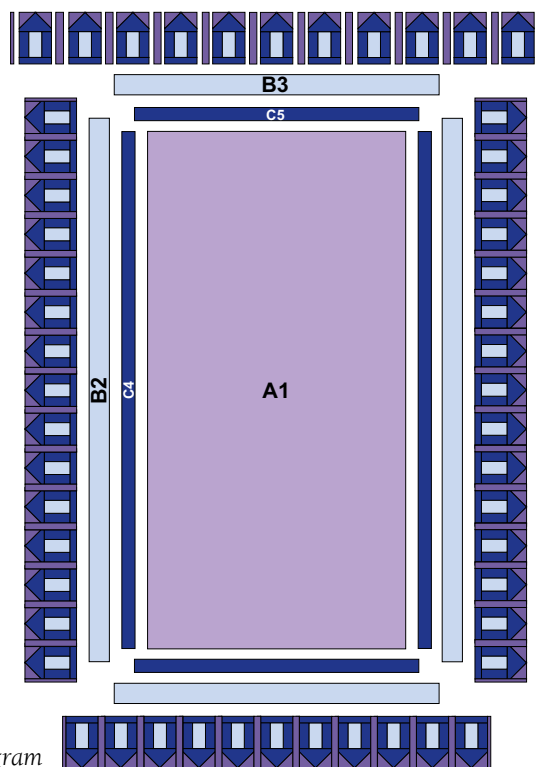
- Cut two ⁴/₁₂" strips. Subcut forty-eight 1" x ⁴/₁₂" D1a strips and eight ³/₄" x ⁴/₁₂" D1b strips..
- Cut five ¹/₄" strips. Subcut one hundred four ¹/₄" squares

QUILT ASSEMBLY: (Refer to Quilt Diagram)

- Sew C4 strips to the sides of the panel. Press seams toward strips.
- Sew C5 strips to the top and bottom of the panel. Press seams toward strips.
- Sew B2 strips to the sides. Press seams toward strips.
- Sew B3 strips to the top and bottom. Press seams toward strips.
- Sew House side strips to long sides of quilt center with roofs pointing out. Press seams toward quilt center.
- Sew House top and bottom strips to top and bottom of quilt center with roofs pointing out. Press seams toward quilt center.

FINISHING:

- Prepare backing with horizontal seam to measure 41" x 61".
- Layer backing, batting and quilt top. Baste layers together.
- Quilt as desired.
- Trim layers even with top.
- Join five ²/₄" C6 binding strips with diagonal seams. Press seams open. Press strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together to make double-fold binding. Sew binding to quilt using your favorite method.
- Make a label and sew to back of the quilt.

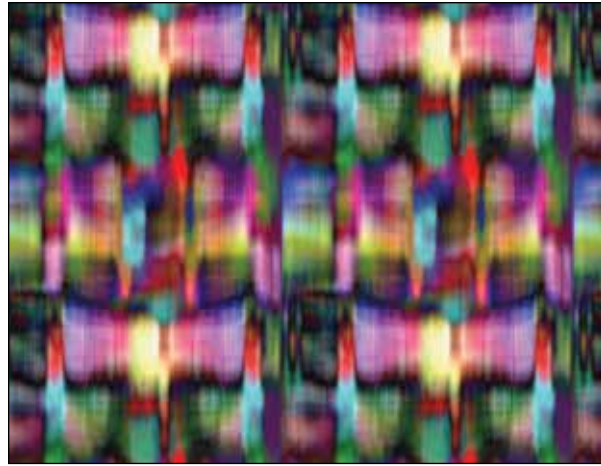


Quilt Diagram
